John 2: Jesus Invited to the Wedding

John 2:1-12: THE WATER THAT WAS MADE WINE

1. JOHN 2:1

- "On the third day there was a wedding in Cana of Galilee, and the mother of Jesus was there."
- -chiastic structure—beginning of chapter—pointing to Jesus' resurrection announced at the end of the chapter.

2. JOHN 2:2

-Present at the wedding: Jesus, His disciples, His mother

3. JOHN 2:3

- -No wine=no joy (Jeremiah 48:33)
- —In other words, a devastating situation.
- -In the context of Messiah, wine is a joy and gift from God (Isaiah 25:6)

4. JOHN 2:4

- -Correcting the Jewish expectations of the Messiah
- -He must suffer first before He can be King (Matt. 16:21-27; Matt. 20:20-23)

5. JOHN 2:5

-Jesus' mother acknowledged His authority

6. JOHN 2:6-8

-Filling the water pots vs. drawing some out

7. JOHN 2:9-10

- -Prophetically pointing to Jesus as the Bridegroom in the Messianic Kingdom, or Millennial Kingdom (1,000 year reign of Jesus Christ—see Rev. 20)
- —Abundance from the land and the marriage itself (Joel 3:17-18; Song of Songs 2:4-5; 4:10)

8. JOHN 2:11

-law of firsts (or first use); usually most important and sets tone for future

9. JOHN 2:12

- -Capernaum, on the shores of the sea of Galilee, Jesus' home base
- -"not many days" because Jesus was sent to preach in other cities (Luke 4:42-44)

John 2:13-25: ZEAL FOR YOUR HOUSE HAS EATEN ME UP

1. JOHN 2:13-17

- **-Passover** (First feast of the Jews, in the spring, the first pilgrimage feast)
- **—Jerusalem, in the temple** (2nd temple period—the temple initially rebuilt by Zerubbabel (see the book of Ezra) and refurbished by Herod the Great)
- -Jesus drove out those who were doing business in the temple
- **—He was angry** because the Jews were making His Father's house into a house of merchandise (Matt. 6:24).
 - —Psalm 69 gives us a picture of the heartache of Jesus as it relates to unrighteousness (Psalm 69:8-12).

2. JOHN 2:18-22

- -The Jews asked for a sign (1 Cor. 1:22; Matt. 16:4).
- -Jesus pointed to **His resurrection** as the sign that He is the Messiah
- —The Jews believed God dwelt **in the temple they built** according to the Mosaic Covenant, but God was doing a new thing through the New Covenant (Acts 7:44-50)
- —Jesus' disciples, being Jews themselves, didn't understand these things at first. But after His resurrection (and the giving of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost) they did.

3. JOHN 2:23-25

- —Get a sense of Jesus' understanding of humanity personally and **His grief over** humanity's sin
- —Since **the fall of creation** in Genesis 3, no man or woman made in His image could walk with God in the garden in the cool of the day (Genesis 3:8).
- -Jesus Himself was the One sent to **restore** sinful man's relationship back to God
